Louisiana Baptist Children's Home & Family Ministries is a faith-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to providing love, care, and hope in Christ to children and families in need. Established in 1899, the Children's Home is an agency of the Louisiana Baptist Convention and is governed by a 17-member board of trustees elected by the Convention to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis.

The Children's Home is recognized by the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) as a "Foster Care Community." Approximately 80% of the children in LBCH foster homes are placed by DCFS and the other children are privately placed by a legal guardian.

The Children's Home receives no state or federal funding. Approximately 79% of all funding comes from individuals and churches. Less than 25% of funding goes to administrative costs; 75% goes to direct ministry services. Less than 8% of funding comes from payment of services.

Our major service areas include: Residential Child Care for Children ages 5-17; Pathfinders Transitional Living for ages 18-21; HomePlace Residential Family Care for Homeless Children and Mothers; Christian Women's Job Corps of Monroe providing job and life skills training and certified HiSET preparation and testing; Granberry Counseling Centers with 11 statewide locations; Connect 1:27 Foster Care & Adoption Ministries; and Orphans Embrace International Orphan Care Mission Trips.

This past year was the first time that we had over 100 children in our off-campus Connect 1:27 foster care ministry. Dozens of families from churches all around the state answered God's call to provide a home for a child in need. ## Meet Ashli, MaKayla & Aleeiya...

### CAMPUS SPOTLIGHT

*“For I know the plans I have for you....”*

Jeremiah 29:11, one of Ashli Buggs’ favorite scriptures, was her lifeline throughout the past year. Ashli’s journey started in December 2016 when she lost her job. A single mom of two, Ashli had worked in fast food and housekeeping, so she had good experience. She promptly started her job search. Even though no doors were opening for her, she knew that God was in control and He had a plan for her family. When her car broke down, that limited the areas where she could apply and, without a job, she couldn’t afford the needed repairs. Still, Ashli was hopeful that she’d find something soon.

Then came a day that was absolutely devastating. While Ashli and her girls were out with someone very close to them, they were dropped off at the Salvation Army Shelter. There was no explanation, no warning. Ashli was in shock, hurt by this betrayal of trust, and she was afraid. She asked God why, how, and what do I do now. She tried to remain hopeful and positive, especially in front of the girls, but she had no idea where to turn. This situation also created a new challenge for her family. She and the girls had a place to spend their nights, but the shelter closed during daytime hours. Ashli and the girls would walk around in a nearby park or the Downtown RiverWalk to pass the time until the shelter opened for the night.

“There were days I had only \$2 or \$3, and the girls would need something to eat. Aleeiya needed shoes. I knew where to go for the cheapest snacks and how to make a few dollars last. I could do without, but I had to take care of my babies.” Even though there were moments when she was overwhelmed, Ashli continued to remind herself and her girls of God’s promises. When she learned that the shelter would soon be closing, a new fear gripped her heart.

One cold, wet, miserable day, she took the girls into an office building to use the restroom and to try and get warm. As she and the girls walked around, Ashli noticed someone watching them. After a few minutes, a gentleman cautiously approached her and

asked if she and her girls were all right. Ashli told him they were fine. The man continued to watch her and asked again if he could help in some way. He didn’t give up, and Ashli finally shared a little of her story. The man took her and the girls into a nearby gift shop and bought them food. He gave Ashli \$10 and a card with his mother’s phone number, encouraging Ashli to make that call. Ashli was hesitant to call a stranger. But, after a few hours, she broke down and reached out for help.

The gentleman, Pastor Marty Campbell, and his mom, Irma, quickly became part of Ashli’s list of “my angels.” Mrs. Campbell invited Ashli and the girls into her home, fed them, loved on them, and started making phone calls on their behalf. Their time at the shelter was coming to an end soon, and Ashli still had no idea where they would go. But now there was a glimmer of hope.



Ashli beams as she shares that the Campbells’ connecting her with HomePlace was truly an answer to prayer, an answer that came in His perfect timing and in a bigger, better way than she could ever have imagined. While there was concern that the application process might not be complete before the shelter closed, Ashli’s reference and background checks came back in record time. On August 24, at 3 p.m., Ashli got the call that she, MaKayla and Aleeiya had been approved. She celebrated, “Lord, You are in control of me and my babies!” And on August 25, Ashli laughs that she was so excited, she and the girls were at the Children’s Home before the staff arrived, ready to move into their new home.

She and the girls have been overwhelmed by the HomePlace Ministry. She had no idea that not only did her family have a safe place to live, they would have much needed clothing and other resources and support as well. Ashli beams as she shares that job offers started coming in. “I actually had to turn down opportunities because, all of a sudden, there were so many.” Susan Clark, Director of Family Care Ministries, and Kathy LaCaze, Maggie’s Place Cottage Mom, have been wonderful encouragers, and they have been such faithful prayer warriors. Everyone here has been so good to us.”

On December 4, Ashli started working at the Rolling Hills Ministry Thrift Store. She loves sorting

# homebuilders...

## The 'Three S Framework:' Spender, Saver, or Servant?

Our Christian tradition has quite a lot to say about giving. However, today's Christians, despite living in the wealthiest society in history, give a relatively small portion of their resources to advance the cause of Christ and to help the poor. There are some notable exceptions to this troubling gap—

Christians who sacrificially submit their financial resources to God in profound and life-changing ways.

Authors John Cortines and Gregory Baumer, through their research in writing *God and Money*, developed a frame of mind that differentiates highly generous Christians from the rest of American Christians. After studying this issue deeply, they concluded that our "money mindset" will make us a Spender, a Saver, or a Servant with our financial resources.

A **Spender**, represented by most people in the Western world, is someone who pursues the greatest possible present consumption, even if mindful of the need to save some.

A **Saver**, by contrast, strives to limit consumption to some extent, focusing instead on increased wealth accumulation.

A **Servant**, possessing the rarest mindset of all, orients their life around limiting both consumption and wealth-building, focusing instead on giving the most money they can toward blessing other people.

Our money mindset is driven by two factors: our temporal focus and our view on the highest purpose of money. Temporally, Spenders maximize value today, Savers maximize value in the future, and Servants maximize value in eternity.

These attitudes are driven by our view of money's purpose. A Spender views financial resources as a way to "live it up," enjoying every part of life that money can buy. Savers have a more complex view of money, viewing it mostly as a tool for security, stability, flexibility, and personal freedom. A Saver's net worth might become a simple way to "keep score" in life. Servants, by contrast, view their money as a potential blessing to the world in Christ's name, desiring to make the most of its potential for eternal impact.

The three money mindsets definitely bleed into one another, but each of us can identify our own core mindset by looking at the highest hopes we have for our wealth. Rather than just examining the percent of income spent, saved, or given, it is better to ask, "Where would I focus my thoughts and efforts if my income began dramatically increasing over time?" If you spend, spend, and spend some more to enjoy all that the world has to offer, you are (you guessed it) a Spender. If you would seek to pay off the mortgage early, retire early, or build a family dynasty of wealth, perhaps you're a Saver. If you would immediately begin thinking about how to give your excess resources to the cause of Christ, you're definitely a Servant.

The highest purpose of wealth, like the highest purpose of our lives as Christians, is not just enjoying life today or finding security for tomorrow. Instead, the purpose of wealth should be to help us glorify God by extending His Kingdom here on earth. Servants know that they need things today, and they also realize that someday they may need to retire, send children to college, etc. However, their primary focus is to serve the Lord Jesus Christ with their money, and this means their decisions may appear inconsistent to both Spenders and Savers.

Most modern personal finance teaching tends to reside somewhere between spending and saving, while failing to recognize the third mindset of Christian Servanthood. Giving generously is encouraged perhaps as one component of an overall plan, but building God's Kingdom here on Earth is not held up very clearly as the central purpose of money. I pray that you will join me in challenging the prevailing framework for thinking about money's purpose in life and have the mindset of a servant!

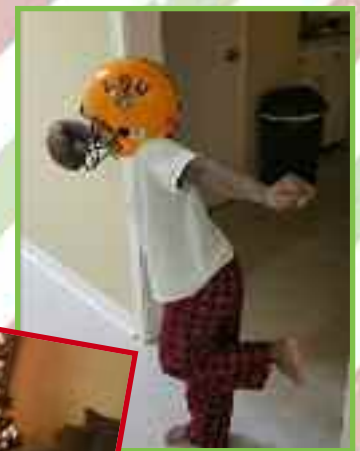

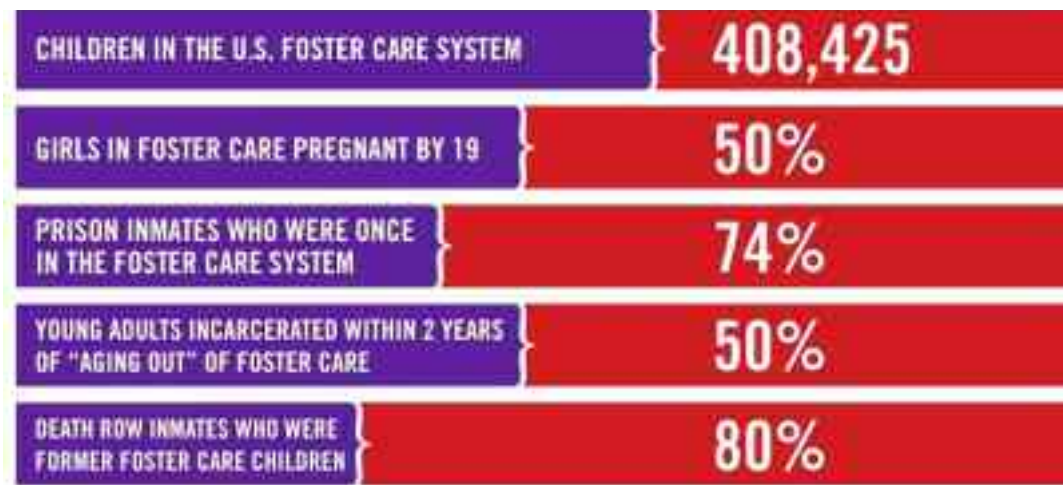

## Q&A With an LBCH Foster Family

### The Haynes Family

*Southeast Louisiana*



Justin and Brittany Haynes are answering God's call to care for hurting children. They have graciously shared with us some of their experiences as a foster family.

#### **How many years have you served as a foster parent, and to how many children?**

We have been foster parents for one year and seven months to six children.

#### **Why did you become a foster parent?**

We knew God had specifically instructed us to become a foster family. We want/wanted to love children and provide stability when they needed it most. Basically...to further serve God.

#### **Why do you continue to be a foster parent?**

We see the need and have a God-given desire to provide a loving home for children when they are in desperate need. We also are increasingly aware of the brokenness within families and want to continue helping share Jesus with the families of these sweet babies.

#### **Describe your family dynamic.**

We are church planters from North GA who moved to New Orleans for seminary first, and then for church planting. We have been married for eleven years and have four biological children.

#### **What is your favorite activity to do as a family?**

We enjoy being outdoors. Some activities are walking/hiking, exploring, sports, and water activities. We love being together and being silly in everyday activities!

#### **What has God taught you as a foster parent?**

-Forgiveness - It is a very difficult task to watch children you love being hurt by those who are supposed to be taking care of them. We have learned to forgive and to love through difficult situations.

-All children are His. Loss is a natural part of fostering and you learn to grieve while drawing closer to God. We can rest in the fact that His kids are in His hands, while they are in our arms and after they are gone.

-To depend on God even more. We have learned that we cannot walk this fostering journey in our own abilities. We have to fully and completely rely on God and His strength.

## Former Resident Who Rode the Orphan Train to Monroe Passes Away

Ola Gleason King and her three sisters entered the Louisiana Baptist Children's Home (which was located in Lake Charles at the time) as young children. The four sisters were living at the home in 1925 when the decision was made to relocate to Monroe. The sisters rode on the "orphan train" which transported the children to the new location.

Mrs. King, a long-time resident of Baker, Louisiana, was one of the last known living alumnus of the Children's Home to have ridden the train, passed away on December 3, 2017 at the age of 104.

In 2001, Mrs. King made her first and only return visit to the Children's Home campus. She shared fond stories of living at LBCH including how she read to then superintendent Frank "Daddy" Flowers just prior to his death. There is still an oak tree standing in front of Joy Cottage (formerly Mary Goss Cottage) that Mrs. King planted in 1925.

According to her daughter, Jo Ann Gorman, Mrs. King was "a dedicated prayer warrior who read her Bible every day as long as she was able."

## Granberry Counseling Centers... Answering God's Call to Care

I always look forward to January. All of our Granberry counselors meet together for a time of training and fellowship at our main office on the Children's Home campus in Monroe. It is a joy for me to spend quality time with our incredible counselors and administrative team.

Every member of our Granberry team really senses God's call to serve in this life-changing ministry. Our counselors are committed Christians who ask God to use their knowledge and skills to serve their clients. They are truly answering God's call to care.

In 2017, our Granberry counselors provided professional Christian counseling for 1,254 individuals at 11 different centers across our state.
