We also have plans to expand our Compassion for Kids ministry to serve more economically challenged children in North Louisiana. We hope to partner with additional churches to increase the number of those children we serve with our weekend food program and our special events.

One of the greatest opportunities we have to reach the next generation of children in need is through our Connect 1 Child foster care and adoption ministry. Louisiana has between 3,500 and 4,000 children in its foster care system. The goal of

Connect 1 Child is to have every child in a loving, Christian home that is supported by a local church.

Our foster care and adoption specialists help churches and Baptist associations develop foster care and adoption ministries for families in their local area. Beginning in February we are touring the state providing the details of this new initiative. We have set aside two Sundays for each month so please call soon to secure your date.

These are exciting days at the Children's Home. God is opening so many doors to reach more people with His love and the good news of Christ. Thank you so much for your continued support. Together with God we are meeting needs and changing lives in Jesus' name at your Louisiana Baptist Children's Home. God bless.

The Nix Family "HomePlace is a Blessing!"

Patricia and her family were familiar with LBCH and HomePlace from a stay several years ago. When Patricia found herself in need last fall, a friend encouraged her to call HomePlace once again. She and her three girls—Shanira, 12, and twins Jayla and Kayla, who just turned 10—were accepted into HomePlace and returned to the Campus in early September. Patricia is thankful for Cottage Manager Yvonne for making her family's move into Mary's Place such an easy transition.

Patricia has welcomed the safe place for her family and says of their home, "I love it here, and the girls do, too." The girls are thriving in their new environment. Shanira is a 7th grader at East Ouachita; Kayla and Jayla are in the 4th grade at Lakeshore Elementary. The three girls are on the A-B honor roll, and Shanira is planning to try out for the dance team. Jayla and Kayla are not sure yet what extracurricular activities they'd like to participate in. "One likes science and one likes to read," says Patricia. "But those two haven't decided on sports or other special interests yet. They all want to go to LSU one day, so I've told them to start working now for scholarships!" She laughs as she adds, "With three of them, there's lots of homework, and the new math is not easy or fun."

Patricia shares that her girls like to stay close to her. "I try to get them to do things with their friends and learn how to be without me for a little bit of time, but they aren't interested. They need to learn how to have that time away from me and one another occasionally, but we will take it day by day."

Patricia works in a local daycare and just completed the course work needed to become a lead teacher. She is in the process of scheduling her exam for certification. With her experience, longevity in her current position, and the addition of her certification, Patricia is excited about her career and opportunities for advancement.

When they're not studying, the girls like robots, TikTok, and watching TV. "We enjoy watching movies together. We like coloring and doing our nails, but the girls do not like shopping!" The girls are involved in a local church where they enjoy their age-group Bible studies, and Patricia always enjoys the family activities that are offered there.

There are cottage Bible studies for Patricia, and she is enjoying both of the current studies. "I love 'The Chosen,'" she says. "We are trying to watch the series together, but it's really tempting to skip ahead. It's so good! The other study is on the mothers and daughters of the Bible, and it's really good, too." An admitted worrier, Patricia welcomes these opportunities, as well as her quiet time, to continue growing in her faith. Right now, she says that her go-to Scripture is Matthew 6:25-34, "Therefore I tell you: Don't worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Isn't life more than food and the body more than clothing? Consider the birds of the sky: They don't sow or reap or gather into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Aren't you worth more than they? Can any of you add one moment to his



life span by worrying?..." She shared that when she is worried, she reads this scripture and goes right to sleep.

Patti describes Miss Yvonne and all the LBCH staff as true blessings. In addition to the Bible studies and moral support, "Miss Yvonne has helped me with things like budgeting and a lot of other things. When I get depressed, she talks with me. There is someone here to talk to all the time, and that's really helped."

Patricia likes that HomePlace helps encourage and mentor in the areas of personal and spiritual growth, and the staff also helps provide the very practical support often needed to help moms get back on their feet. "My transportation became an issue, so Miss Yvonne has helped me get to and from work, and she gets Shanira to school and her activities. That means a lot."

Patricia enjoys her private time at the end of the day. "After the girls go to bed, I enjoy the peace and quiet. I read devotions, then turn on a TV show I like to watch. That's my 'peace' time." Patricia also thinks about the future and dreams of the day she is independent. "I want a home of my own," she says. She's also decided that her home will be in this area, close to family and her support systems. "My mama is in West Monroe, and I talk to her almost every day.... I told my kids I'm not moving. I want to stay here in the country. I love fishing. It's safe here, and it's so peaceful. I'll stay here."

The HomePlace Ministry has been such a blessing in so many ways, and Patricia recommends it to other moms in need. "It's a good place to be. I tell others that they will have to follow the rules, and you have to stick with it. The staff here motivates you a lot, and there's always someone here to help you, someone to talk to you." She's excited that one of her friends is participating in the ministry now, too, and is doing well.

Patricia is happy with the progress she's made thus far, and she's excited that her girls are doing so well. HomePlace has given her and her family new hope for the future.

Money, Possessions, and Eternity

Yad Vashem is Israel's largest Holocaust memorial. It sits on the slopes of the Mount of Remembrance on the edge of Jerusalem. It details the history of the Jewish people during the Holocaust for remembrance by future generations.

My wife and I recently had the privilege of touring Israel with a group from New Orleans Baptist Seminary. Going through the Holocaust Museum was a very sobering experience. It reminded me of the movie, *Schindler's List*.

At the conclusion of the movie, there's a heart-wrenching scene in which Oskar Schindler—who literally bought the lives of many Jews from the Nazis—looks at his car and his gold pin and regrets that he didn't give more of his money and possessions to save more lives. Schindler had used his opportunity far better than most. But in the end, he longed for a chance to go back and make even better choices.

As Christians, we do not get a second chance to live life over, next time doing more to help the needy and invest in God's kingdom. Missionary C. T. Studd said, "Only one life, 'twill soon be past; only what's done for Christ will last." We have one brief opportunity—our lifetime on earth—to use our resources to make a difference in people's lives and bring glory to God.

Jesus said, "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. 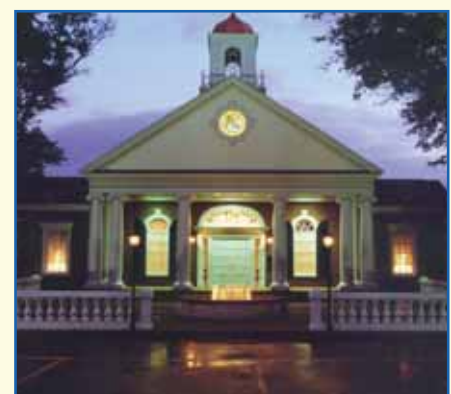

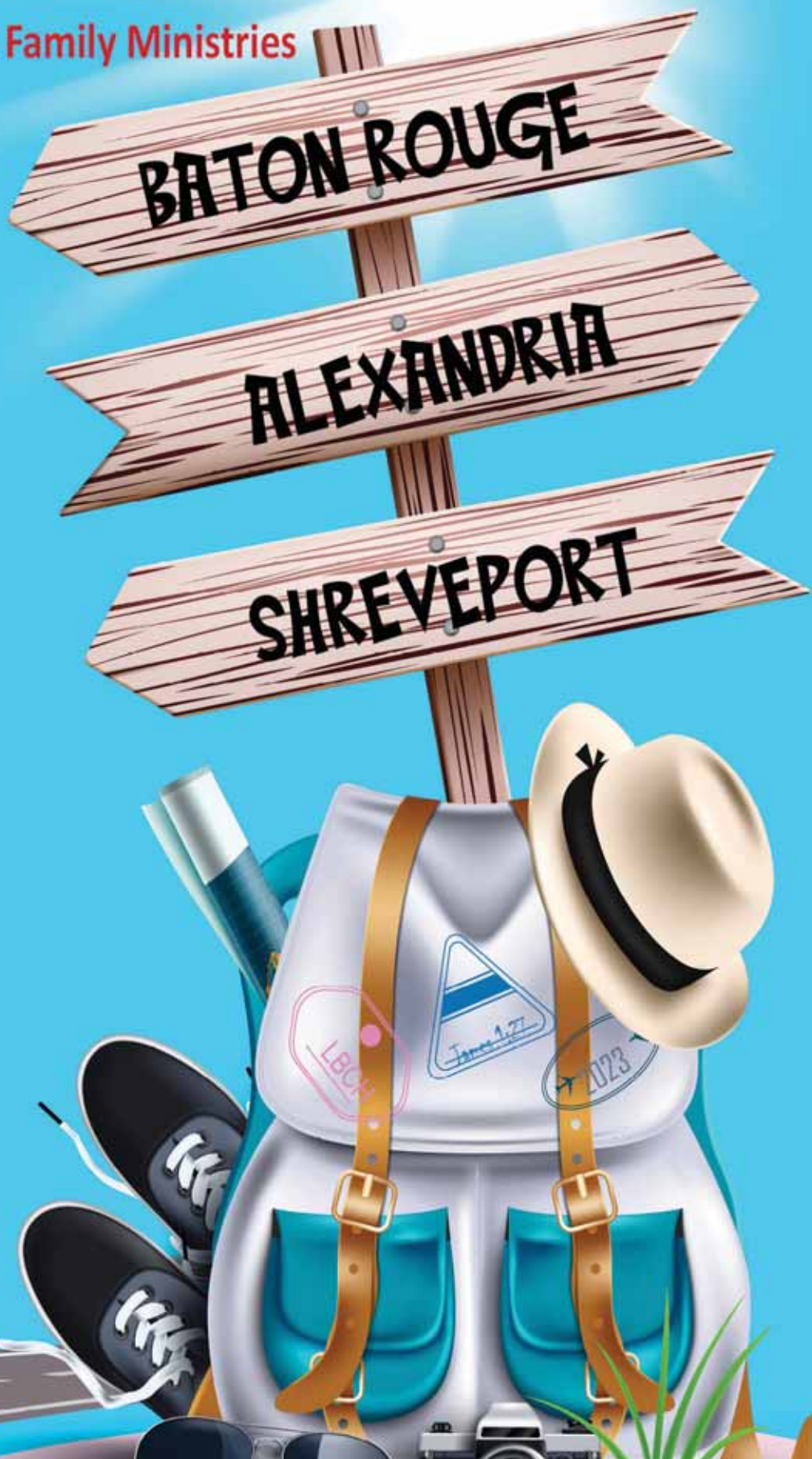

We continue to guide our moms about the importance of saving money and ending debt. We also encourage the moms to continue with academic training or job skill training at the Women's Learning Center. As the year unfolds, some families move out to live independently for the first time in their lives. New families will enter with the hope of a better tomorrow. The HomePlace staff shed tears, give hugs, and continue to create a refuge for new families.

Being a Person of Hope in a World of Anxiety and Brokenness...

I recently read of a carload of Christian missionaries who were coming into a small Middle Eastern town that sits on the northern edge of a “developing” country. Intermittent terrorist attacks and a struggling economy make “disintegrating” seem a more realistic description. When the locals met the missionaries at the gate leading into their town, they asked, “Why are you here?” “This country will never be fixed.”

“You don’t have to live in a broken country to know something of the same hopelessness – the overwhelming sense that some aspect of your life can never be fixed. Far too many people live day in and day out with a sense of brokenness that leads them to believe ‘nothing is ever going to change.’”¹ They may not voice it out loud, but they’ve come to expect that God is never going to answer prayer and a cloud of hopelessness begins to overshadow their lives.

Proverbs 13:12 states, “Hope deferred makes the heart sick.” “When our expectations are delayed for a long time, we can experience disappointment, disillusionment, and loss of hope. In some cases, prolonged waiting for what we eagerly desire can become such an affliction that it differs little from a lingering sickness. This is the meaning of Solomon’s words ‘hope deferred makes the heart sick.’”²

No one likes waiting. I’ve never met someone with the “gift” of waiting. But I have learned over the years that what God wants to do in our lives while we wait, can be more significant than whatever it is we’re waiting for.

“Dashed hopes sicken the heart, and the higher the expectations, the greater the frustration.”³ Waiting is an opportunity to trust God and allow Him to work in our lives. I have witnessed the Lord work through Christian counseling to heal broken

hearts, overcome the effects of trauma, strengthen character, and transform clients into people of hope.

Being people of hope in a world filled with anxiety and brokenness doesn’t mean our circumstances will always change; it does mean our hearts can change.⁴ We may feel the tension between God’s promises and our seemingly hopeless circumstances. And yet, by God’s grace, we can choose to hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, who entered the very pit of hopelessness and three days later came out the other side.⁵

As Christian counselors, we seek God’s healing presence in the counseling relationship and help clients face past hurts, walk through a difficult present, and progress into a future filled with hope.

“Christian hope, then, is not the kind that blindfolds itself to reality. It’s the kind that looks at a newly sealed tomb and says, ‘This story’s not over!’ Jesus’ empty tomb stands as a solid, immovable witness that brokenness is ultimately beaten.”⁶ Therefore, we can be people of hope.

Louisiana Baptist Children's Home & Family Ministries is a faith-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to providing love, care, and hope in Christ for children and families in need. Established in 1899, the Children's Home is an agency of the Louisiana Baptist Convention and is governed by a 17-member board of trustees elected by the Convention to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis.

The Children's Home is recognized by the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) as a "Foster Care Community." Most of the children in LBCH foster homes are placed by DCFS and the other children are privately placed by a legal guardian.

The Children's Home receives no state or federal funding. Approximately 74% of all funding comes from individuals and churches. Less than 25% of funding goes to administrative costs; 75% goes to direct ministry services. Less than 7% of funding comes from payment of services.

Our major service areas include: Residential Child Care for Children ages 5-17; HomePlace Residential Family Care for Homeless Children and Mothers; Women's Learning Center providing job and life skills training and certified HiSET preparation and testing; Granberry Counseling Centers with 12 statewide locations; Connect1Child Foster Care & Adoption Ministries; and Orphans Embrace International.

Our dedicated Christian ministry team strives to offer the highest quality of services. Services are provided without regard to race, gender, religion, or ability to pay.
